Treasurer

The treasurer is the custodian of the PTO's finances and budget, pays expenses, maintains all fiscal records; completes the annual taxes; and presents a financial statement at every regular meeting. **Position can be split among two volunteers.**

Commitment:

- 18-20 per quarter

Walk-A-Thon Planning Committee

This annual fundraiser in September supports every Beattie PTO effort, from community nights to extra field trips to classroom supplies. **We need a minimum of two to three volunteers.**

Commitment:

- 4+ hours planning meetings
- 10+ hours event preparation
- 7 hours day of event
- Donations volunteer: 10+ hours during campaign

Student Picture Day & Yearbook

Design our annual Beattie Elementary yearbook and coordinate student picture day. **One volunteer needed.**

Commitment:

- 3+ hours on school picture day & redo day
- 7+ hours yearbook design

Fifth-grade Promotion

This position secures fifth grade's bowling trip, Salt Dogs game, chairs and buses, sucker sales, photo booth and more for Beattie's graduating class. Typically is a fifth-grade parent. **One volunteer needed.**

Commitment:

- 15 hours over course of year
- 10-15 hours the final week of school

Fall Fun Night & Art Night

One of the main goals of Beattie PTO is to help build a sense of belonging for all Beattie Families and enhance the Beattie community. We do it by hosting free family events. **Two volunteers needed to lead planning**, one for Fall Fun Night and one for Art Night.

Commitment:

- 4+ hours planning and coordinating co-volunteers

Student Enrichment

Beattie PTO works to provide enrichment opportunities for students through extra field trips and in-school educational assemblies, such as Wildlife Encounters, STEM assemblies, or Humanities Nebraska Speakers Bureau guests. Help secure trips and buses. **One volunteer needed.**

Commitment:

- Varies, but typically 3-7 hours between August and September
